- 2006-2007** Oliver joined Bingham penguins swimming club for the disabled.
- 2007-2008** Won Bingham Penguins junior most improved award 2008 for all his hard Work through training.
- 2008-2009** Won Bingham Penguins Junior outstanding award 2009 for winning a bronze medal and gaining 2 PBS at the British learning disability champs. Winning gold and bronze at the Downs national championships. Selected to train with the GB Downs squad and made two out of three consideration times for the downs world championships in Taiwan. Oliver also got invited to train with Nova elite squad through Notts County Council which is an intense training course for the best in the county.
- 2009-2010** Won Bingham Penguins Junior outstanding achievement 2010 for breaking Two junior world records for 100m free and 50m back a the European downs championships held in Southampton. Oliver was then selected to represent Great Britain in the Downs world championships held in Taiwan in October, where he smashed his own world record for 100 m freestyle by 13 seconds, he also broke the 200 free and 100 backstroke and also got two European records for 50 fly and 50 free.

- 2010-2011** On the 16th of April Oliver competed at the Europeans downs championships In Southampton breaking three more World records for 200m backstroke, 100m breaststroke, and 100m IM.

- On the 6th of August Oliver competed at the Disability champs held at Ponds Forge Sheffield where he broke two junior world records for 50m backstroke and 200m freestyle and got European record for 50 freestyle.
